In the event that your child has to self-isolate, the information below is designed to help and direct you to video lessons and resources provided by the Oak Academy. These will support you in delivering learning at home.


English Reading: Read for at least 20 minutes each day. This can be independently, with an adult or sibling. Discuss some of the questions from your reading bookmark with an adult.
