Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our learning about the Stone Age to Iron Age, we are planning to take the children to an incredibly exciting, hands-on learning experience at Brighton Museum which will link directly to our immersive Mantle of the Expert approach to the teaching of this subject. The dates that we are booking for this trip are 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> November (Please see below for when your child's class will be going).

The trip will include a Stone Age Session run by museum staff in the Elaine Evans Archaeology Gallery, independent time to explore the gallery further, and then the chance to see inside the Royal Pavilion.

Dates for the trip:

3 Red and 3 Blue will go on **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November**

3 Amber and 3 Sapphire will go on **Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> November**

3 Yellow and 3 Green will go on **Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November**

We will be travelling to the museum by public bus in order to keep the cost of the trip down. On the day that your child's class is going, they will need to be at school at the normal time, in their school uniform, with suitable outdoor layers for cold/wet weather.

We will be having lunch at the museum so all children will need a packed lunch on this day. **If your child is entitled to free school meals, please let us know if you would like a school packed lunch to be provided.**

We would be very grateful for parent volunteers from each class to help us with the trip. On the days of the trip, we will be leaving school at around 9:00am and returning to school at around 1:45 – 2:00pm. If you are able to help with your child's class, please speak to the class teacher.

In order for this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a **contribution of £10.50** that will cover both the cost of the bus travel and the museum experience (including workshops). You will be able to pay this sum using the school **Parent Pay** system. If you have any questions please ask at reception or speak to your child's class teacher.

We are delighted to be able to offer such a rich, topic-based learning experience to our children that is just on our doorstep!
