Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic this term, *Brighton Rocks!*, we would like to take the children to an incredibly exciting, hands on learning experience at Brighton Museum. This trip will take place on the following dates:

Wednesday 2 nd November	5 Blue and 5 Red (PR)
Thursday 3 rd November	5 Amber and 5 Sapphire (HR)
Friday 11 th November	5 Green and 5 Yellow (PR)

The trip will include a local history session run by museum staff, which involves hunting for clues about a mystery Brightonian from the past through the Lanes around the museum! We will also get to look around the museum exhibition itself.

We will be travelling to the museum by public bus in order to keep the cost of the trip down – we will be taking the number 49, which is a direct route to North Street from School Road (PR)/Palmeira Square (HR).

On the day that your child's class is going they will need to be at school on time, in their school uniform, with suitable outdoor layers for cold weather. We will be having lunch at the museum so would like all children to have a packed lunch on this day. Please indicate on the attached form if your child is entitled to free school dinners and needs the school to provide a packed lunch.

We would be very grateful for parent volunteers to help us with these trips. On the days of the trip, we will be leaving school at 9:15 and returning to school at around 1:45 – 2:00. If you are able to help with your child's class, please indicate on the attached form so that we can contact you to confirm.

In order for this trip to go ahead, we are asking for a contribution of £10.50 that will cover both the cost of the bus travel and the museum experience (including workshops). You will be able to pay this sum using the school's online, Parent Pay system. If you have any questions please ask at reception or speak to your child's class teacher.
