Dear Families,

It's been a busy two weeks here at HLF! What has struck us most is the wonderful amount of singing happening all across the school and the enjoyment our children are getting from it. From practising for One Voice at The Dome, to our school choirs and Sing Up assemblies, as well as the rehearsals for the fab finishes, singing 🎵 has filled the halls and our hearts in the lead-up to Christmas.

Thank you to everyone for your well wishes regarding the generous gift and donation to the school. We will be passing these messages on. We are looking forward to welcoming you all into school next week for our nativities, fabulous finishes, and Christmas gatherings run by the PTAs and FOWHIS.

Bowls of Belonging

A huge thank you to Layla Blaxstone, our publisher, and to Caroline Kemp Harris, our EYFS and Infant PSHE Lead, who have worked tirelessly on this event and book launch for the federation. Last Thursday, everyone came together to cook and share the meals and recipes showcased in the books, raising money for the schools. It was wonderful to see so many of you and to share food together.

Collaboration Update

The federation will continue to work collaboratively with Brunswick Primary in the spring term, and staff have enjoyed the opportunities to work with them on school improvement. We have been working on several projects, including maths, focusing on increasing attainment and progress for all children with an emphasis on challenge at all levels. In January, we are sharing a joint INSET with three workshops exploring the question: How do we ensure QFT for all educationally disadvantaged children so that attainment, progress, and challenge in maths are increased for all?

Looking Ahead: AI and Our Schools

We're excited to announce that we're working with Digital Resistance CIC to begin internal conversations about AI and what it means for our schools. This partnership will help us prepare for the future while keeping children's well-being and online safety at the heart of everything we do.



Physical development across the Federation

At the start of this academic year our Reception team set out their aim to further support children starting school with their physical development: building strength, fine and gross motor skills, flexibility and independence. Recent guidance suggests that children between the ages of 1-5 should have at least 180 minutes of movement a day and our Reception team wanted to ensure they get as many opportunities to be active as possible. Thinking about ways to encourage:

- participation
- repetition
- combined learning opportunities
- sparking or tempting activities, games and resources
- opportunities to experiment with movement

the Reception leads Ms Kemp-Harris and Miss Rogers created wish lists of equipment they needed to supplement their current outdoor spaces and provide the most robust zones for physical development. Overwhelming generosity from the parents, carers and family members within our school community alongside contributions from our PTAs have meant all items on these lists have been purchased. The targets for these initial playground zones have been met and we are seeing children go from strength to strength as they explore, investigate and thrive in these spaces.

Looking to the future, we will be working on developing further zones in our playgrounds on each site so that all children across the federation can grow through the power of play. Further details on the project will be shared in the new year.

We look forward to welcoming you back to school for the spring term on Tuesday 6th January, and we wish you all a very merry Christmas season. Thank you for your continued support and for helping to make our schools such a happy and fulfilling community.

Attendance at Hove Learning Federation

Attendance and Punctuality:

Good punctuality is an important life skill and arriving at school on time each day makes a real difference to children's learning.

Research consistently shows that good punctuality supports both academic success and overall wellbeing and that arriving at school on time each day makes a real difference to children's learning.

Our school gates are open from 8:40-8:50 at PR and HR (8.45-8.55 at SR) but bringing children for 8:40 (8:45 at SR) gives the best start to the day.

Those first ten minutes are designed to help pupils settle calmly, greet their friends, organise their belongings, and take part in important morning routines such as registration and early-start tasks.

When children arrive late, even by 5-10 minutes, they can miss the calm, structured start, and key explanations that help them feel settled and confident.

Over a year, arriving just 10 minutes late each day can add up to more than 30 hours of lost learning time. By arriving promptly at 8:40, children begin the day feeling ready, organised, and fully prepared to make the most of every learning and social opportunity.

In summary: good timekeeping isn't just about being "on time" – it helps children grow into confident, capable learners and sets them up for success in school and beyond.

By working together to support punctuality, we give every child the best possible start to their day.

Lateness

Arriving late to school is very unsettling for children, and frustrating for teachers who have to repeat instructions and help children to catch up. In terms of time in school lost it can have a considerable impact over the whole school year:

5 minutes late every day = 3 days of school lost a year

10 minutes late every day = 6.5 days of school lost a year

15 minutes late every day = 10 days of school lost a year

20 minutes late every day = 13 days of school lost a year

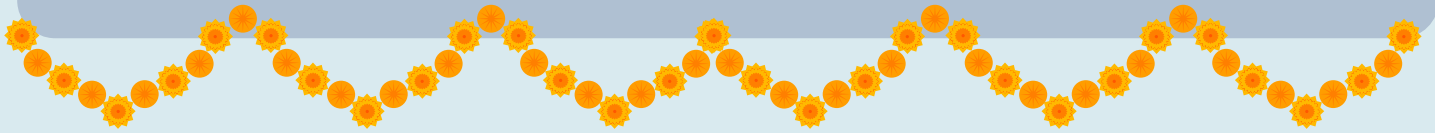
We have been really proud of just how much improvement there has been regarding parking illegally outside the school over the last term. Thankyou for parking safely and respectfully for all our pupils and school community.

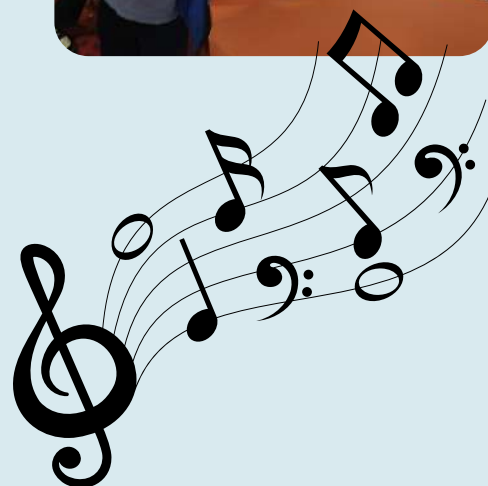

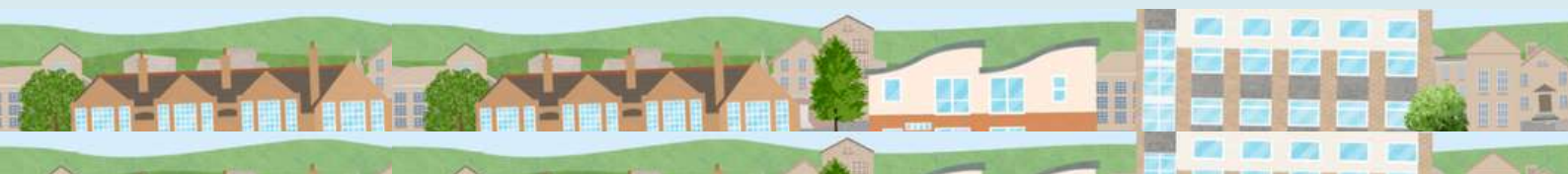

Would you like to work or volunteer at our Federation?

Our wonderful Federation of schools, are currently looking for reading volunteers as well as paid exciting opportunities to boost your income. For reading volunteers we are keen to provide a volunteer reader to a year group in your child's school site, so they can get to know the children and provide additional support for fluency if you have a free afternoon or morning each week. Grandparents or other family members are also encouraged.

For our federation job roles these can be flexible and part time if you're wishing to add extra regular income - these might just be for you!

Vacancies at Holland Road/Portland/School Road

Breakfast club - these could be anything from 1-5 mornings a week 7.40am until 8.40am. You would be welcoming and supporting the children with breakfast and a relaxed start to the school day.

Midday Supervisor (MDSA) roles - This runs from (12-1pm at Holland Road and 12.20-1.20pm at Portland Road) daily and can be a combination of days that suits your needs. During this time you will be helping guide children to the lunch area and supporting them in play within the playgrounds.

School run Afterschool club - The clubs run from 3pm-6pm daily, working on days where the need is higher. During this time the children wind down from a busy day of learning and take part in crafts, play and a snack time. Joining our already strong teams will help maintain a safe and fun environment for our children.

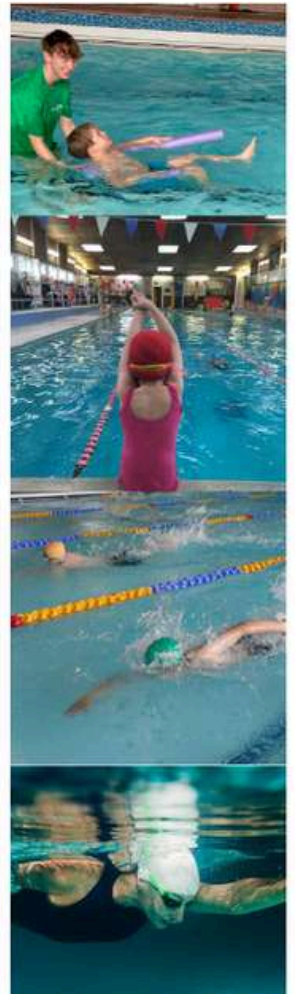
