Dear Families,

Like you, we're incredibly proud of our wonderful school. You, your family, all our pupils and teachers make our school a very special place to learn. Each September, we request a £30 contribution for the schools for each pupil for their year group. **The contribution in both the Junior and Infant Schools pays for year group workshops, topic visitors and additional resources for topics and subject areas across the academic year that all pupils access as part of the curriculum. Paying this all together stops us having to ask for other one of payments apart from external trips and swimming costs.** The School Fund is separate from FOWHIS & our PTAs fundraising.

- Each year group will receive a 'topic' based workshop/visitor each term e.g. Stone Age/Viking Workshops
- Core texts and additional reading resources for each year group.
- Additional year group resources for topic stunning starts and fabulous finishes
- Art/DT resources for art week, topic work and enterprise initiatives.

- Yr 4 Soundmakers Music Programme
- And so much more!

This can be paid as a one-off payment on Parent Pay or in three termly amounts of £10. Details of how to use parent pay are below. Alternatively, you can set up a regular standing order to the school.

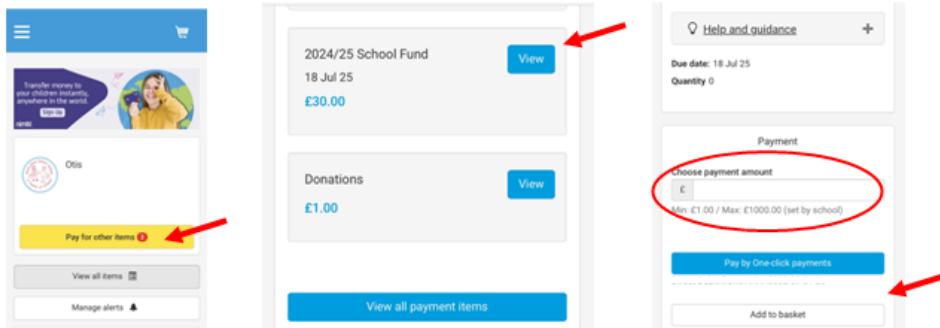
