

Whole School Messages

Thursday 11th June 2026

School Road:

From September Brighton & Hove City Council will be enforcing the school streets scheme around West Hove Infants/Hove Junior schools using ANPR and CCTV. This is aimed to help keep children safer on the walk to school.

The aim of School Streets is to help reduce congestion and dangerous or illegal parking but also creates more space for children and families to walk, cycle or scoot.

Exemptions:

The following vehicles are exempt from the restrictions but will need to be added to an exemption list:

- driving a vehicle registered to an address within the restricted area (including those of businesses and residents)
- a Blue Badge Holder who needs to access a property within the street
- a Professional Carer or a Carer for vulnerable residents who live on the street
- An emergency services vehicle on an emergency call
- a utility provider on an emergency call
- an employee, or working with, a business or service operating within the street
- driving a contracted school transport vehicle

Those wishing to apply for an exemption will be able to do so via the council website. This will be available well in advance of enforcement starting in September.

Class photos will be taken on Tuesday 7th July. **If you were e-mailed on 9th June in regards to giving your consent, and have not yet done so, please log in to your Arbor and give permission.** If you need help with this, please speak to the school office. **Please note that without this consent, your child will not be included in the class photo.**

A letter was sent home last Thursday with information about the upcoming sports days. **Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch to school on the day of their sports day. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and will require a school packed lunch, please let the school office know as soon as possible.**

All children should come to school in their PE kit on the day. Please try to provide t-shirts to represent their class colour if possible (we can provide team bands if needed). Please consider the weather carefully on the day and ensure your child has sun cream, a sun hat and bottled water if needed. We would really appreciate parents/carers to help us walk to and from the park on the day. We will be leaving in the morning after the register for a 9:30am and returning after lunch. Please inform your child's class teacher prior to sports day if you can help. Please feel free to come to the park to support your child and join us for a picnic lunch.

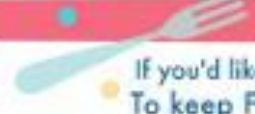

Fred's shed is located in the juniors front playground just next to the main gates

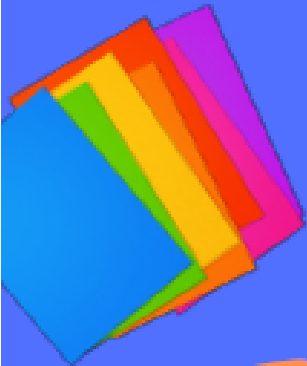
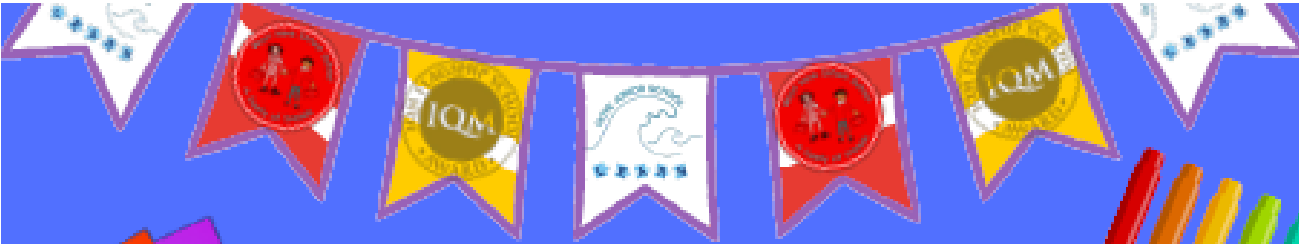
