Sea safety and offshore wind warning:

Please take extra care if you're visiting Brighton & Hove's beaches. Offshore winds can quickly carry people away from the shore, particularly if using paddleboards, inflatable dinghies, inflatable toys and lilos, kayaks or small personal watercraft. Even confident swimmers can get into difficulty if they are swept further out to sea than expected.

Before entering the water, check the weather, wind and sea conditions, avoid using inflatables in offshore winds, stay within your abilities, never enter the water alone, tell someone where you're going, carry a device for calling for help if taking part in water sports, wear a buoyancy aid when paddleboarding, kayaking or taking part in similar activities.

The sea can be colder than it looks - Cold water shock can affect breathing and movement, even on warm days.

Don't chase inflatables - If an inflatable blows away, let it go. Do not enter deeper water or try to swim after it.

Know what to do if you get into trouble - [Float to Live advice](#):

Tilt your head back with your ears submerged, relax and try to control your breathing, move your hands to help stay afloat, spread your arms and legs, once breathing is under control, call for help or swim to safety if possible

Cliffs are dangerous - Keep away from the base and edge of cliffs. Chalk cliffs can collapse without warning.

Stay out of restricted areas - Follow safety signage and instructions from lifeguards and beach staff.

If someone is in trouble - At the coast, call 999 and ask for the Coastguard, if safe to do so, keep watching the person and direct emergency services to their location, do not put yourself at risk by entering the water.
