Welcome back!

A very warm welcome back to our wonderful children and families. We hope you all had a lovely summer break and are ready for another exciting school year!

To our new families joining us, welcome! We are delighted to have you join our school community and look forward to getting to know you and your children. We hope you have a happy, exciting and memorable start to school with us!

To limit the number of e-mails sent home, a weekly bulletin is e-mailed to you every Thursday. The newsletter is sent home bi-weekly on a Friday.

At the start of the academic year, we need to send out a higher number of emails that include key term time information, individual logins, invitations to parent workshops and other start of school details. We are aware that this will seem like a high volume of messages which is why we make every effort after this initial settling in period, to keep school messages down to one weekly bulletin. We would like to thank you in advance for your understanding.

Scooters and bikes:

A gentle reminder that scooters and bikes are not to be ridden on the school premises before or after school. Please safely walk them in to school at the beginning of the day and avoid riding them at the end of the day until you have left the school gates. Thank you.

School Fund:

A reminder that a letter was e-mailed home on 3rd September with information on the voluntary £30.00 that we request from families at the start of each new school year. The school fund is separate from the PTA fundraising and goes towards each year group receiving a 'topic' based workshop/visitor each term, core texts and additional reading resources, additional resources for topic stunning starts and fabulous finishes, Art/DT resources for art week, topic week and enterprise initiatives, Saplings resources for our 'Forest School' curriculum, Year 4 Soundmakers music programme and so much more.

This can be paid as a one-off payment on Parent Pay or in three termly amounts of £10.

The letter includes details of how to use Parent Pay as well as the school bank details should you wish to set up a regular standing order.

Please be aware that there is no obligation to contribute, and no child will ever miss out as a result.
